GENERAL MEMBERSHIP MEETING
August 13, 2007

Meeting called to order by President, Eric Hesselberg at 7:15 PM, 17 members present.

Secretary's Report: The minutes from April were read and a motion was made by Chase Miller; and it was seconded.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report was read and a motion was made by Chase Miller and Marv Lehmann seconded it. Eric said we should make a payment of \$3,000.00 on the long range this month.

League Report: Marv Lehmann let us know that to become a referee it costs \$21.00 if you are over 18 years of age for a background check etc. and is good for 3 years It will be reimbursed if a member of our association.
